a puppalicious doggie birthday cake

Puppy got a birthday coming soon? This scrumptious (but not too naughty) cake will be sure to make it a special day!

ingredients

cake

- 4 cups The Honest Kitchen Force™ dehydrated dog food
- 2 tablespoons The Honest Kitchen Ice Pups™ frozen treat mix
- 1 cup of chicken stock
- 2 free range eggs
- 3 tablespoons honey
- 1 cup plain yogurt
- 1/2 cup smashed up The Honest Kitchen Smooches™ or Nuzzles™ cookies

icing

1 cup plain yogurt

2 strips bacon

what to do

- 1. Preheat your oven to 350°F.
- 2. Grease a 10 inch cake pan (you can use butter or vegetable oil).
- 3. You can also line the pan with a strip of wax paper to encourage easy release.
- 4. Combine in a bowl the Force[™] and the Ice Pups[™] and sift together.
- 5. In a separate bowl, combine the eggs and the yogurt.
- 6. Whisk at high speed for 3 minutes. Gradually add in honey.
- 7. Reduce the speed to low and add in the dry mixture cup by cup.
- 8. Stir in the smashed up cookies.
- 9. Bake in the oven for 25-35 minutes, until you can insert a toothpick and it comes out clean.
- 10. Allow the cake to cool on a rack for 10 minutes.
- 11. Cook the two pieces of bacon and chop them into small pieces.
- 12. Carefully invert the cake onto a serving dish.
- 13. Ice with the plain yogurt, sprinkle with bacon bits and serve.
